Health and Education are the wealth of the country. The N. S. Memorial College of Nursing, envisioned in 2012 under the management of Kollam District Co-operative Hospital Society in continuation to the establishment of the health care institution named NS Cooperative Hospital in 2006. NSMCON was aimed to cultivate a new generation, with the knowledge, skill and attitude to provide nursing care to the sick and the disabled and to bring about new innovations in the field of nursing education.

NSMCON is one of the most distinguished institutes in Kerala for training nurses. The college is recognized by Indian Nursing Council (INC), New Delhi, Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council (KNMC), Thiruvananthapuram and affiliated to the Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS), Thrissur, Kerala. The College of Nursing has six full-fledged departments – Medical Surgical Nursing, child health-Nursing, Mental Health Nursing, Community Health Nursing, Obstetrics and Gynecologic Nursing and Nursing Foundations. At present the college is offering B.Sc. Nursing programme with 60 intake.

The college is located in N.H bypass, Palathara, Kollam, Kerala, India which is 7.5 Km away from Kollam bus stand and 6 Km away from Kollam Railway station.

The administration of NSMIMS is controlled by an eleven member Executive body as per the Co-operative Department rules and regulations. Our society owns over 25 acres, which is NS Memorial Institute of Medical Sciences (NS Co-operative Hospital), NS Ayurvedic Hospital, NS Nursing College, NS Post Graduate Institute for Medical Sciences, NS Diagnostic Centre, NS Drugs & Surgicals etc. It is governed by the guiding principles of providing medical services to patients with care, compassion, and commitment.




N.S. Memorial Institute of Medical Sciences aims at providing the best of medical facilities and services at affordable costs. The hospital which started as a small venture has undergone remarkable growth in infrastructure facilities and general amenities over the years. More than 1500 patients attend the Outpatient Department daily, which is the largest OPD census second to that of District Hospital, Kollam, shows that the hospital is one among the most popular hospitals in Kollam district. Every year more than 6 lakh patients benefit from our services and the hospital has become an icon of healthcare in Kerala.

Ours is a 500 bedded Hospital with an outstanding medical team consisting of 130 doctors & 1400 Nursing, medical, and paramedical staff with 36 Multi-Super Speciality departments. Our 9 storied super-specialty block started with facilities like 1.5T wide-bore MRI, 128 Slice multi detector CT and modern cath lab units. It was a dream-like achievement for the society to get accredited by NABH Safe-I. Our hospital got the “Best Co-operative hospital in Kerala” award from the Kerala state government in 2019 and 2020. We are proud to say that our treatment cost is 30% less than our neighboring hospitals. We are providing discount facilities to the economically backward section of society (AAY) with a reduction of 30% in the overall bill (excluding medicine charges) and a 10% discount on all medicines. The institution stands with a vision to serve the poor. We consider this as our responsibility to serve the society.

There are almost all the specialty departments with 2-4 units in each department and super specialty departments like Cardiology, Pulmonary medicine, Nephrology, Neonatology, Gastroenterology, Neuromedicine, General surgery, Plastic surgery, Neurosurgery, Reproductive medicine, Foetal medicine etc. More than 100 doctors provide round the clock medical care to patients in the hospital.

COURSE OFFERED

Bachelor of Science-Nursing (B.Sc. Nursing)

Four years(8 semesters) full time course (As per syllabus of INC and affiliated KUHS)

DURATION

Duration of the programme shall be four years (Eight semesters). Integrated practice is incorporated with respective practical hours in each semester from Semester I to VII. Semester VIII is the period of internship intended for intensive practicum/residency posting.

ALLOCATION OF SEATS

The N. S. Memorial College of Nursing has an annual intake of 60 seats for the B Sc (N) course. The details about these are given below:

- ▶ General Merit-50%(Allotment from Government prepared merit list-LBS allotment)
- ▶ Management Quota-50%

HOW TO APPLY

I.

- A candidate who seeks admission to the N S Memorial College of Nursing, Kollam, under the management quota should submit an online application in the website of the college www.nsnursingcollege.in from 17/06/2024 to 17/07/2024
- Application fee of Rs.600/- to be remitted through online payment. Application fee once paid will not be refunded.
- Along with the application form the following should be uploaded.
- Passport size photograph of candidate taken after 01.01.2024
- Signature of the candidate
- Copy of SSLC certificate
- Mark list of qualifying examination
- Rank list will be published in the college website on 22.07.2024 as per the admission schedule approved by AFRC.

II .

- A candidate who seeks admission to Government merit quota may apply through LBS/other agency endorsed by DME/Government to complete the admission process as per guidelines.

SELECTION

Selection of the candidates will be purely based on merit, according to the marks obtained in the qualifying examination, (Physics, Chemistry & Biology of Second year) a rank list will be prepared and published in the college website on 22.7.2024. The candidates are requested to verify the marks entered in the website and report to the college mail if any discrepancy noted. Percentage of marks will be calculated for preparing rank list by normalization in different streams. The schedule of admission will be informed through online in the college website .

Resolving of tie while ranking:

In case of a tie in the total marks computed for ranking, candidates with higher marks obtained in Biology (in the final year of the qualifying examination) will be placed higher in the ranking. If the tie still exists, the candidate with higher marks obtained in Chemistry (in the final year of the qualifying examination) will be placed higher in the ranking. If the tie still exists, the candidate with higher marks obtained in Physics (in the final year of the qualifying examination) will be placed higher in the ranking. If the tie still exists the percentage of total marks for plus one and plus two together and then the percentage of marks in English (in the final year of the qualifying examination) will be considered for breaking the tie. Even after this, if tie remains, the age of the candidate will be taken into account and the older will be placed higher in the ranking than the younger. If the tie still persists, tie will be resolved by criteria as decided by Selection Committee.

Candidates should bring the following documents in original for verification at the time of admission.

1. Print out of online application
2. Allotment memo
3. Copy of Aadhar
4. SSLC certificate
5. Mark list of qualifying examination
6. Certificate in proof of OBC/SC/ST status if applicable
7. Course certificate and Conduct certificate
8. Transfer Certificate

9. Migration Certificate (if needed)
10. Medical Fitness Certificate from a registered Government Medical practitioner having MBBS or higher qualification
11. Seven passport size photo & four stamp size photo
12. Undertaking regarding non-involvement in ragging
13. Two sets of photocopies of documents from 1 to 8 in the list

It is the responsibility of the candidates to ensure that the qualifying examination he/she has passed is recognized by the Kerala University of Health Sciences as eligible qualification for admission.

The cut off date of admission to Nursing Course will be as per the notification issued by the KUHS and Government of Kerala.

PS:-As a routine, no other fee than that is given above will be collected by the college. PTA,SNA,NSS & College Union fee will be collected as per regulations.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on or before 31st December of the year of admission (As per University norms)
- The minimum educational requirements shall be the passing of Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination (12 years course), or Senior School Certificate Examination (10+2), Pre-Degree Examination (10+2), or an equivalent with 12 years schooling from a recognized board or university with Science (Physics, Chemistry, Biology) and English with minimum of 50% aggregate marks (as per KUHS & INC norms). The due concessions in the minimum percentage of marks for SC/ST candidates are as per university regulations.
- Candidate shall be medically fit.

LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

In case any student admitted to the course discontinues, the institution is entitled to collect the tuition fee of the entire course as liquidated damages. However the collection of liquidated damages will be as per the final decision of the AFRC/Court. It is subject to the legal and factual scrutiny of the AFRC, when any complaint is submitted before the Committees on such matters. In such cases the Certificate and TC of the student leaving the college shall be released on the condition that the student and his father/mother execute a bond undertaking to pay the amount that would be ordered by the AFRC or the Court of Law.

CURRICULUM

The N.S.Memorial College of Nursing follows the Curriculum prescribed by the Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur and Indian Nursing council

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIOS

UNIFORM

- Students are required to wear the uniform prescribed by the college during clinical experience.
- Students should have their hair put up and should wear prescribed footwear only, during clinical experience.
- Students are not allowed to wear any jewellery except small earrings during the clinical experience.

STUDENTS ACTIVITIES

- Students are expected to participate in all the activities organized by the college. Students are encouraged to become members of the Student Nurses Association. The Student Nurses Association will provide a means of personal and professional development for the nursing student.
- To use leisure time creatively and effectively, they are provided with facilities for indoor and outdoor games.
- Educational trips are arranged for the students every year. Educational trips will be charged during the course and students will have to bear the full expense of the trip. Free conveyance may be available for short distance.

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CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE

- Students are responsible to the Principal for the behavior both in and outside the college.
- Students should maintain silence in the class, library and in the corridors when lectures are in session.
- Students should make every effort to take care of the college, hostel and hospital property.
- Any willful damage done to the property of the college, hostel and hospital will be dealt with as a breach of discipline.
- Students are required to abide by the rules and regulations laid by the hospital, and college authorities. Violation of rules will entail disciplinary action.
- Students are required to maintain ethical and professional standards and behaviors.
- Students should not involve themselves in any religious activity publicly in the campus during their tenure in the college
- Students who are found to have major health problems and unable to continue the course viz., cardiac problems, epilepsy, tuberculosis, infectious skin diseases, psychiatric problems or any other major illness will have to discontinue their course and the fees paid will not be refunded.

HEALTH PROGRAMME

Each student will undergo an annual medical checkup. Students will be immunized against infectious diseases as and when necessary. If illness occurs during their course they will be cared for in the hospital on payment.

HOSTEL

Hostel facilities will be provided to the girls and boys as required.

Rooms are provided with furniture. Each student must bring bedding/mattress, a pillow, 4 bed sheets, 2 pillow covers, an umbrella and a watch with a second hand.

They should not bring any valuable jewelry. The college will not take any responsibility for loss or theft.

Food will be provided in the hostel. The charges for each month will be fixed. Boarding charges must be paid at the beginning of the academic year.

Parents and students are required to read and sign the hostel rules. The same will be given to the student at the time of admission.

RAGGING

Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in the college and hostel. All the members of the college are committed to abolish ragging in the campus. Hence any student who indulges in any form of ragging will be subjected to penal actions as per provisions of law. Also the student will be expelled from the college as detailed in the law concerned. Students and parents have to submit an undertaking regarding non-involvement in ragging in the given format at the time of admission. 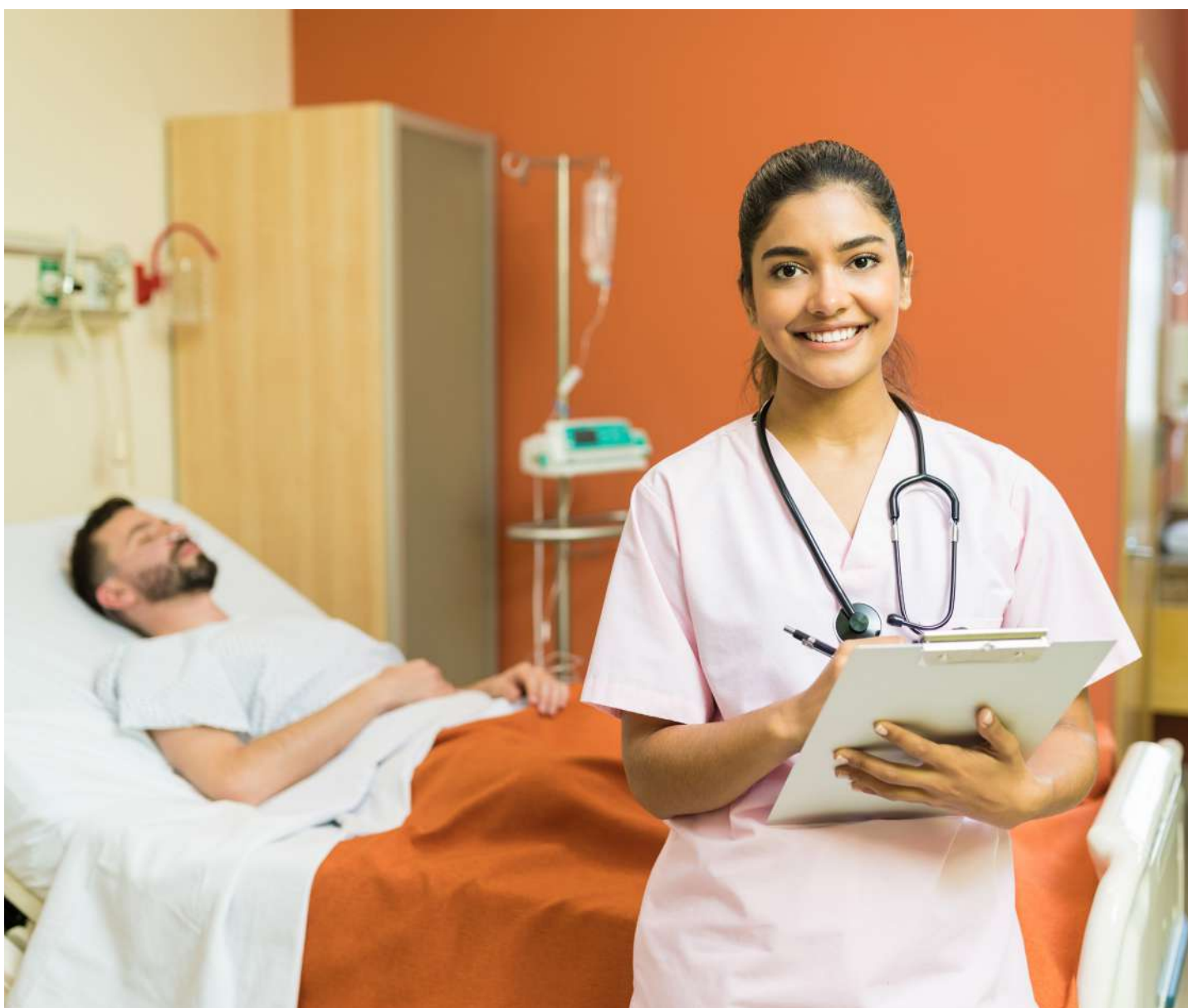
INTERNSHIP
